## HORSE CARE PACKAGES

We have three levels of care available to you - based on your particular budget...

- "The Works" includes: feeding 3x/day, fresh water daily, cleaning 2x/day, blanketing below 50 degrees, supplements at noon, turn-out every other day. \$18.00/day
- "Still Spoilin' em a bit" includes: AM/PM Feeding, fresh water daily, cleaning once per day, your supplements at noon, turn out every other day. \$15.00/day
- "Budget Minded" AM/PM Feeding, fresh water daily, cleaning once per day, if staying 3 or more days, turn out 2x/week. \$12.00/day

## CUSTOM CARE...

Talk with us about pricing on custom care packages that meet specific needs of your horse. (Including invalid or senior care or doctoring if needed). Special feeds or hay needs could be obtained for your horse if available.

## A VARIETY OF SIZES OF PENS, STALLS AND PADDOCKS ARE AVAILABLE:

### We keep your horses healthy!

If your horse becomes ill or injured, we will contact you immediately, and follow your instructions.

If we cannot reach you, we will contact your vet for appropriate care.

To assure each horse leaves as healthy as they came in, we at Superstition Stables feel it is imperative that ALL horses boarded (short or long term) must meet minimal health requirements as indicated below:

### Horse Health Requirements

Negative Coggins test within the last 12 months or proof that your horse has been within the State of Arizona for the last two years.

- Influenza (used to prevent nasal and some viral nasal conditions)
- Rhinopneumonitis (used to prevent colds)
- Strangles (intranasal)
- Rabies
- West Nile
- Tetanus
- Equine Encephalomyelitis - Eastern and Western (used to prevent sleeping sickness)
- On a current deworming program

Proof of all above can be copied from your veterinarian's records or if you do your own inoculations - your records.
